All contestants are to check in upon arrival. The contestant will then draw a number and the number will be placed on a card to place in front of the ribs. Once numbers are assigned to each entry, contestants will then draw another number to

see which entry they will serve. Winners and prizes will be announced between 3:00 and 4:00.
